

## Chapter 3

### ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES\*

#### Sec. 3-1. Open containers.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to have on his person, in his vehicle, or in his possession any open container of beer or any other beverage containing alcohol.

(b) Any person found violating this section shall be subject to a fine of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or thirty (30) days imprisonment.
